## POLLING METHODOLOGY

Our philosophy about which population to use depends on the election, but we are generally comfortable with a "likely" model (as opposed to a "registered" model) for most elections. For this poll, we chose a sample of known Republican households across the state for an automated poll. We only sampled respondents who indicated they had some likelihood of attending the Iowa caucus.

The survey was conducted November 2. The margin of error, with a $95 \%$ confidence interval, was $4.3 \%$. $54 \%$ of the respondents were female, and $46 \%$ were male. The geographic breakdown of the respondents was as follows: $20 \%$ came from the 319 area code, $25 \%$ came from the 515 area code, $10 \%$ came from the 563 area code, $20 \%$ came from the 641 area code, and $25 \%$ came from the 712 area code.
