

# Nevada Poll Results Tarkanian 44%, Heller 38% (17% undecided)

#### POLLING METHODOLOGY

For this poll, a sample of likely Republican households for an automated poll was chosen from the population registered to vote in the state of Nevada, and there were 500 completed responses.

The survey was conducted October 24-26. The margin of error, with a 95% confidence interval, was 4.4%. The geographic breakdown of the respondents was as follows: 11% from the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District, 42% from the 2nd Congressional District, 25% from the 3<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District, and 22% from the 4th Congressional District (*The explanation of the boundaries of these regions is graphically depicted in Exhibit A at the end of the poll analysis*).

### **POLL RESULTS**

#### **SUMMARY**

JMC Analytics and Polling independently conducted this poll for the Nevada U.S. Senate Republican primary to be held next year. Next year's Senate race already has national implications, given that (1) Senator Heller won his first term in 2012 with a 46-45% plurality, (2) in last year's Presidential election, Hillary Clinton carried the state 48-46%, and (3) Democrats only need a net pickup of three seats if they want to regain the majority. However, as the poll will show, Senator Heller has a more immediate problem: he faces a substantial primary challenge as well.

On the primary ballot test, Tarkanian has a 44-38% lead over Heller (he led 39-31% in August), despite Heller's Congressional experience. Not only does Tarkanian lead in three of Nevada's four Congressional districts, but he has across the board leads from a gender and age perspective as well.

Senator Heller's problems are two-fold: (1) Tarkanian has higher approval ratings (59-24% vs 51-43% for Senator Heller), and (2) President Trump's approval among Republicans is very high (85-13% favorable), and by a similar margin (86-11%), respondents are more likely to support a candidate who "actively supported the President's agenda."

In summary, Senator Heller faces a substantial primary challenge from Danny Tarkanian in a race that ultimately could determine partisan control of the U.S. Senate.
